Footprints In The Sand

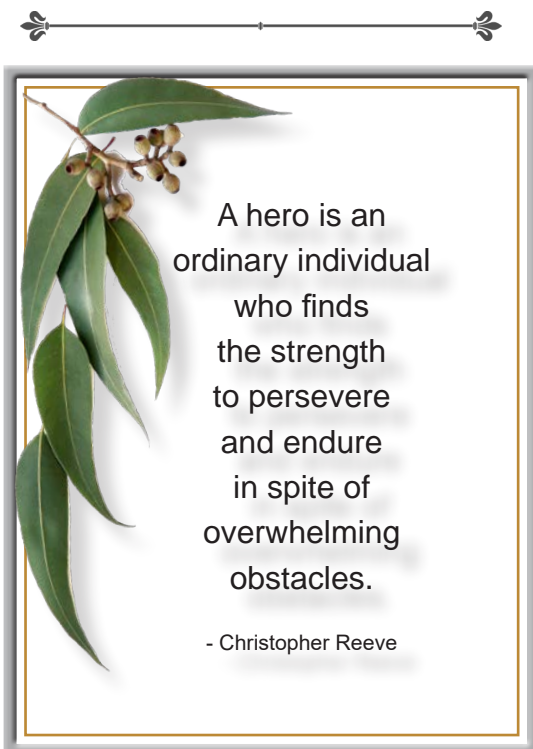
